CMI Congregation, the first indigenous Religious Congregation in India, aims at the integral

The college is well-equipped with good quality infrastructure for academics as well as extra-curricular and co-curricular activities. CMI management has been investing enough to modernizing the image of the college. The new block viz St. Joseph Block is partially complete and hostel rooms are renovated by laying vitrified tiles.

The college also provides Basketball, Volleyball, Football, Throw ball and Cricket Grounds. Our Campus is under the CCTV surveillance for the safety and security of the students.

The library has a collection of 17835 books, 1000 e-books and 60 Magazines. 2000 books were added during the current year. Due to COVID 19 pandemic 9 HOD and Staff meetings were conducted Online in this academic year in which the Principal and faculty members discussed and planned various activities.

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Social Awareness and Extension Activities

Our College has adopted 5 villages around our College (Keelavadagarai, D. Mary Matha College in Response to COVID 19 Pandemic

COVID 19 brought innumerable miseries to all the sections in the society. During the initial months as a helping hand we distributed Rice, Vegetables and essential commodities to the most deserving families in the Silvarpatti village in collaboration with the Silvarpatty, Panchayath, We printed 5000 face masks and distributed to the villages around and gave awareness about COVID 19 SOP. One day Online training program on “Psychosocial Care during COVID 19” for faculty members and students was organized on 21.07.2020 in Zoom Platform in collaboration with MKU and M. S. Chellamuthu Trust and Research Foundation. Presidential Address was delivered by Prof. Dr. M. Krishnan, Honorable Vice Chancellor of MKU.

Theni District Administration requested our boys’ hostel and College for accommodating COVID 19 patients. First it was started as a quarantine center and then as a Siddha COVID care center for more than 3 months till August 2020. More than 300 COVID positive patients were successfully treated here. All the rooms in the hostel and some of the class rooms in the College were exclusively used for the purpose. We appreciate the understanding of the students and faculty when their own rooms were given out even losing their luggage and valuable items. The College had to suffer a lot since it was the admission time and many were afraid to come to the campus. We restricted ourselves to online admission.
